Information Collection & Use

FJCP collects personally identifiable information from our users at several different points on our Web site.

Registration

In order to use this Web site, you must first register, receive a username. We collect your personally identifiable information during registration where you are required to provide your contact information (such as name, phone number, and email address).

Subscription

OpsCheck(tm) is a subscription-based service. We request certain personally identifiable information from our subscribers to process your subscription. You must provide contact information (such as name, email, physical address, company name and address). We use this information for billing purposes and to set up your account. If we have trouble setting up your account, we will use this information to contact you.

Account Information

We collect third-party personally identifiable information on our site. When a user creates an account, they have the option to add more users to their account. This information is not used for any promotional purposes by opscheck.com. We use this information to provide the communication services requested by the user. We do not share this information with any third parties. After you register, we will occasionally send you information on product updates, new features, and promotions.

Uses of Information

FJCP uses the collected information for the purposes of understanding our users' geographic and demographic distribution, to improve and modify our products to better meet our user's needs, and to enable effective communication with our customers.

Communications from the Site

Service-related Announcements

We will send you service-related announcements on rare occasions when it is necessary to do so. For instance, if our service is temporarily suspended for maintenance, we might send you an email. Generally, you may not opt-out of these communications, which are not promotional in nature.

Cookies

A cookie is a small text file that is stored on a user's computer for record-keeping purposes. We use cookies on this site. We do not link the information we store in cookies to any personally identifiable information you submit while on our site. We use both session ID cookies and/or persistent cookies. We use session cookies to make it easier for you to navigate our site. A session ID cookie expires when you close your browser. A persistent cookie remains on your hard drive for an extended period of time. You can remove persistent cookies by following directions provided in your Internet browser's "help" file. We set a persistent cookie to store your passwords, so you don't have to enter it more than once. Persistent cookies also enable us to track and target the interests of our users to enhance the experience on our site.
